

Don Edwards Fish & Wildlife Service Pond Clean up and Blind Repair Work Days

The Don Edwards San Francisco Bay National Wildlife Refuge is requesting volunteers to clean up and repair blinds in Ponds AB1, AB2, A2E, and A3W. This effort is being managed by a group of volunteers whom will responsible for this effort.

The work party days will be the 3rd Saturday of each month. The planned work party dates will be: July 17th, August 21st, September 19th. Additional work party days may schedule dependent on the need.

There will be volunteer vehicle access through the Mountain View Gate and Sunnyvale gates.

There will be a marked special combination lock on planned work days, the number is 2010.

Volunteers will need to sign in at the regular check points. There will coordinator contact information at each checkpoint.

There will be areas for debris piles located by each pond. The FWS will clean up the debris piles.

There will areas for Blind building materials located by each pond. Blind material may be left at these locations for all to use. You may bring your own blind building material if required. Please see the volunteers for locations.

Volunteer's boats must be removed at the end of each work day, and only 4 stroke motors are allowed.
