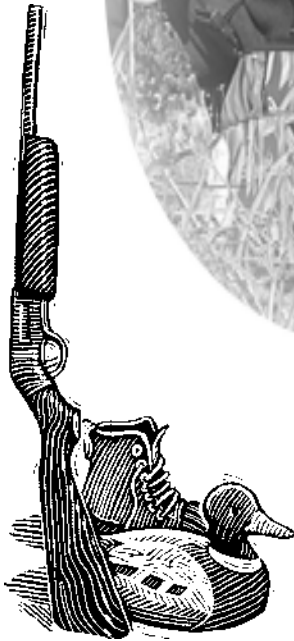


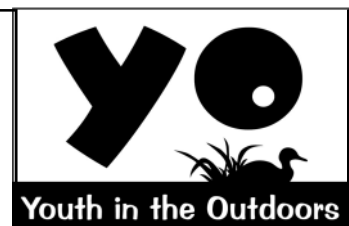

February 3rd and 4th, 2007 have been designated for special youth hunts on both public and private lands for most of California.\* This is an excellent opportunity to bring young people from your family or neighborhood out to enjoy a day in the blind. Many state wildlife areas and federal refuges will be open for junior hunters on these days. Reservations to hunt these public areas can be made through the California Department of Fish and Game's regular reservation system, with applications due by January 17th. Juniors can also hunt without a reservation. In the past, most public areas have had plenty of available spaces.

## A FEW HUNT DAY RULES

To hunt, juniors must be age 15 or under, have completed a hunter education course, and possess a valid California hunting license. You are not required to have state or federal duck stamps. When hunting, you must be accompanied by a non-shooting adult, age 18 or older.
