Applications must be postmarked on or before the application due date, which is Tuesday, January 20th for all Imperial Valley hunts. Successful applicants will be notified approximately 10 days after the application due date, and will be required to pay a \$20 per hunter per day Access Fee in order to use any SHARE property.
