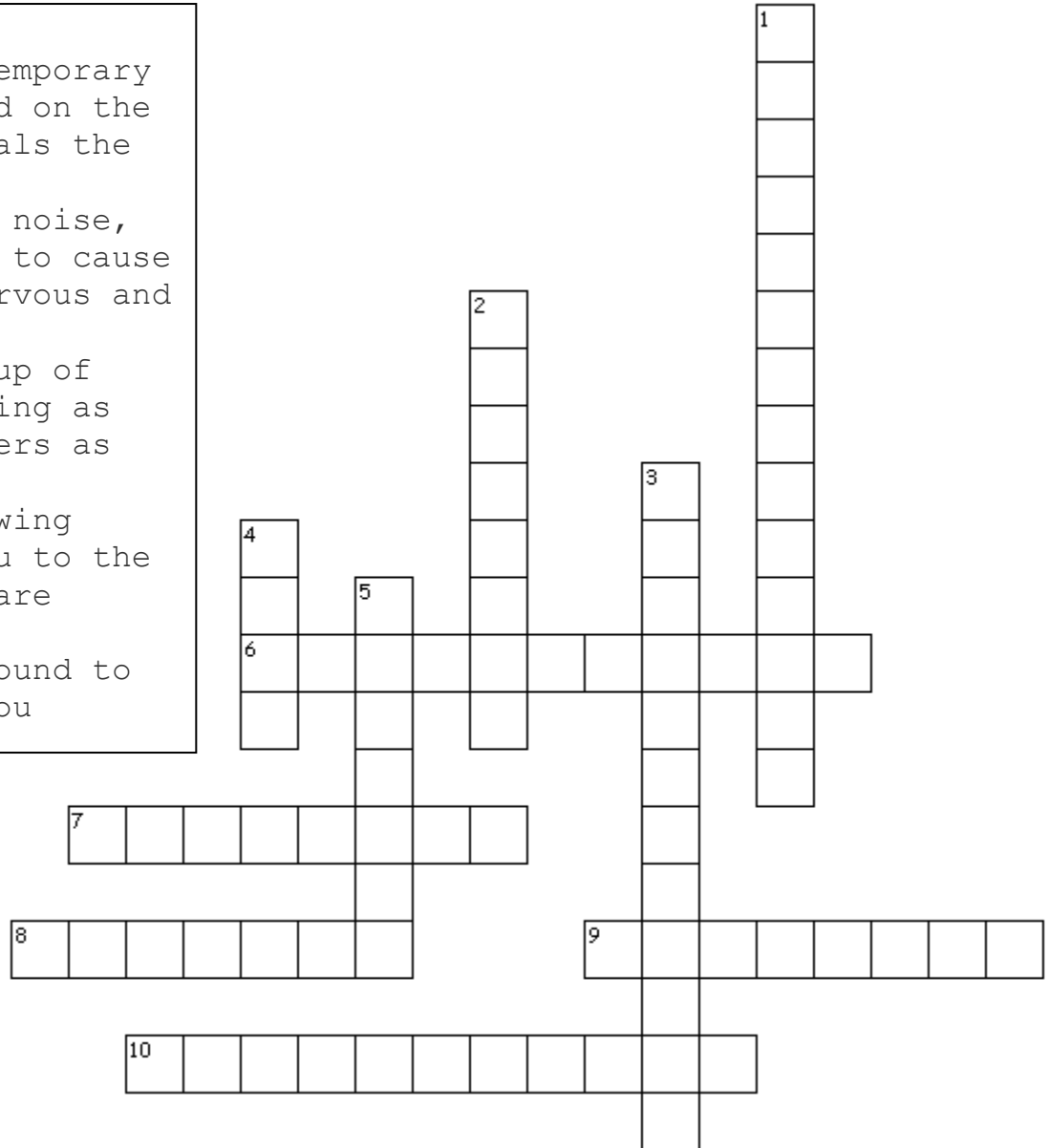


Using the clues below, fill in the crossword puzzle with the Hunting Strategies from Chapter 4!



**Across**

- 6. Makeshift or temporary structures located on the ground that conceals the hunter
- 7. Involves using noise, movement, or dogs to cause game to become nervous and leave cover
- 8. Involves a group of hunters, some acting as "drivers" and others as "posters"
- 9. Involves following tracks to lead you to the type of game you are hunting
- 10. Imitating a sound to draw game in to you



**Down**

- 1. Above-ground seats or blinds that conceal the hunter above the level of the quarry
- 2. This is a tool used to manage natural resources; usually you capture furbearing animals with this technique
- 3. Involves stopping for long periods to scan and listen for game
- 4. There are several breeds of these that can be used to hunt different species: pointers, retrievers, spaniels, and hunting hounds
- 5. Effective when you know where the game is traveling each day and you're not allowed to use a blind or stand
